The PDMT (*Professional Diploma in Mathematics for Teaching*) program, housed in **EPI•STEM**, offers upskilling for out-of-field math teachers. The program meets the Teaching Council's registration requirements for maths teaching and is a joint collaboration between six higher education institutes, with a National Coordinator and National Programme Administrator in the University of Limerick.
